ORDER DENYING

FINDINGS OF FACT

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the party and subject matter.
2. That good and sufficient reason does exist as a matter of law to DENY the applicant's request for a name change pursuant to N.C.G.S. 101.6:

No person shall be allowed to change his name under this Chapter but once, except that he shall be permitted to resume his former name upon compliance with the requirements and

procedure set forth in this Chapter for change of name, and except as provided in subsection (b) of this section.
