Thank you for your patience in this matter involving [REDACTED]. A decision has been made concerning your request for a special transfer to [REDACTED] Elementary School for [REDACTED]. The decision is that [REDACTED] has been granted a special transfer to attend [REDACTED]. When [REDACTED] enrolls at [REDACTED], he will be enrolled under his legal name. He will also be enrolled as a male.

The [REDACTED] dress code will apply to [REDACTED] attire the same as it applies to all other students who attend [REDACTED]. This means that he will be required to dress as a boy or dress in gender neutral attire. To allow [REDACTED] to dress as a girl and to come to school as a girl would disrupt and interfere with the learning environment at [REDACTED].

One of the District's most important priorities is to provide a learning environment that is safe for all children. [REDACTED] provides a safe learning environment to students who attend, which includes [REDACTED] if he chooses to attend [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] staff who will work in direct contact with [REDACTED] will be provided training to assure that they are able to appropriately read and respond to [REDACTED] unique needs. Staff working with [REDACTED] will also be made aware of the need to be alert and respond to any situation that they might observe or hear of where [REDACTED] is subject to bullying.

[REDACTED] made great academic strides while he was enrolled at [REDACTED] Elementary. We expect that he will continue to make appropriate and better than appropriate academic strides at [REDACTED] Elementary staff looks forward to [REDACTED] being a new student. If you want [REDACTED] to attend [REDACTED] you should enroll him as soon as possible.
